



Welcome! I am so glad you decided to take time out of your day to sit a bit and learn a little more about Victory Alliance! Our program is unique and the first of its kind in our area. Victory Alliance is a dedicated hybrid program designed to come alongside our area's homeschooling community to offer professional educational guidance and assistance, encouragement, and an opportunity to put some flexibility in your schedule. We recognize the value of cooperative learning, and we want to make that available to your family without you having to give up the homeschooling values that you hold so deeply.

We offer a consistent program that is all things Language Arts, Mathematics (including upper level math) and Hands-On Science. Enrolling your student in Victory Alliance frees up your time to focus more on the things that you *love* about homeschooling. Since we meet with your student two to three days each week, you have the time to dream up, plan and actually *do* the field trips, unit studies, and other adventures important for your child. No longer will you have to use your planning time to conquer that grueling Algebra lesson to be ready to explain it the next day and answer your child's questions. We are here for some of the heavy lifting.



Not all parent-teachers are as excited about math, grammar and science as we are, and that's OK! Those things are more fun and frankly, often easier for your kids to learn alongside a few like-minded peers and our degreed teachers who are geeked about it! Funny thing is our students often follow in stride and realize how fun mastering these things can be. While solving complex equations or sentence diagrams on our *Smart Boards* or *iPads*, it is not uncommon to hear a student exclaim:

“Hey! This is actually kinda fun! Give me another one!”

It appears that our enthusiasm is contagious, and we love that! Once kids realize that learning hard things *is* actually fun, because God has pre-installed everything they need to reach their fullest potential in a safe, joyful and encouraging environment, they soar! Kids love working on our giant whiteboard wall and our Smartboards. Success breeds more success at the Alliance *and* at home!

By letting the teachers at Victory Alliance carry part of the load, parents may find that the learning environment at home becomes less stressful. Often we also see the relationships and attitudes with and among kids at home improve.

No more stressing, fighting or arguing about those difficult grammar lessons or complex math problems. No more ambiguous video lessons.
No more thoughts of giving up on homeschooling.
Help is here at Victory Alliance!



Victory Alliance can free you up to plan and make those memories, do those projects, and actually make them happen *without* feeling like you are neglecting something or someone else. Without the daily frustration brought on by too many subjects, or too kids and not enough day, your kids will catch your enthusiasm for what you are *fully* prepared to teach, just like they do ours! That's when the stage for some serious learning is set.

Our program maintains the core of homeschooling values. It is relaxed and casual. Kids are even welcome to wear their favorite slippers at school. We have no uniforms or dress codes, and simply ask that kids show up clean, healthy, and ready to learn.



We are by design a multi-age program. This gives us the flexibility to shift kids around to exactly where they need to be for the concepts they need to learn. If there is a child who is ready to learn a concept beyond their *current* curriculum, they can be invited into that next level. Likewise, as sometimes is the case, when a student has a gap in their understanding, we can shift and adjust things to make sure it is filled. On any given day, you will often find kids of all different ages learning concepts together.

We believe that curricula should be fitted to the child, rather than forcing the child to fit the curricula. Short of Cinderella's step-mother, no parent would dream of forcing a child's foot into poorly-fitting shoes and then ask them to wear them all day! Why would we not fit a child's curricula to their level as carefully as we fit shoes to their feet? We can do this! We have a vast library of bound, electronic and subscription-based curricula available, and a wide understanding of what works for different learning styles. The subscriptions alone would cost an individual family hundreds of dollars, let alone hundreds of hours navigating them. We can test drive as many approaches and levels as necessary. A single grade level out of a box of a full curricula does not fit every child for every skill every day.



Grade levels were designed for organizing masses of children efficiently and for the convenience of government schools. While there are some benefits to this, few of them are for the individual child. Not all kids sleep through the night, walk, or lose their baby teeth at the same age; nor do all kids learn to read, multiply or do abstract math at the same age. We get this! Once kids realize how uniquely God created them, and for goodness sakes, that they are never *behind*, it takes an enormous amount of pressure off them! We are always on the brink of waiting for the next victory in learning. Our students become free to actually safely make the mistakes necessary to learn fearlessly! Watching and celebrating one another's victories helps kids see that victory is attainable. Knowing this creates an inner desire to challenge themselves to experience individual victories.



Where is Victory Alliance located?

Victory Alliance is centrally located in Traverse City. We are hosted by Fellowship Church Church. (2555 Garfield N) Our classrooms are big and bright and have lots of room for hands-on learning.

Does Victory Alliance follow a traditional September-June calendar?

Our program is currently scheduled to run on Tuesdays and Thursdays or Mondays and Wednesdays. Currently additional tutoring slots are open on alternate days at an additional cost.



Our 2025-26 program will begin on 9/9/25 and conclude on 5/5/26

Our program will be closed on 11/25 for Thanksgiving break and will resume 12/2

Our program will be closed on 12/23 for Christmas break will resume 1/6

Our program will be closed beginning on 3/31 for Easter break and resume on 4/7

Our final day of 2023-2024 programming will be 5/21

What time does Victory Alliance begin and end programming for the day?

Our doors open at 9:45 and classes begin at 10:00 AM. Our day ends at at 4:00 PM. We ask that students arrive and depart promptly.

How will my student get to Victory Alliance?

Parents are responsible for transportation to and from the Alliance. Carpooling is encouraged.

Will Victory Alliance close if there is inclement weather?

Enrolling your student at Victory Alliance may give your kiddos a few of those very rare snow days that homeschoolers get! Victory Alliance programming will close if TCAPS/NES closes. There is always an announcement prior to 8 AM on our facebook page. Please be certain your notifications for this page are on.

What supplies will I need to provide for my student to attend Victory Alliance?

All students should have:

- Water bottle (Silicone preferred in Elementary)
- 20 age-appropriate pencils
- Pack of 12 colored pencils
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pack of Markers
- 1 pack of Dry Erase Markers
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container of hand soap
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 box of plastic forks and spoons
- A pencil bag that will hold other supplies in addition to pencils
- 100-page perforated notebook
- Headphones or earbuds. Headphones can be corded or Bluetooth
- Backpack



Additionally, each ELEMENTARY STUDENT should have:

- A clearly labeled traditional 1x1 storage cube for personal belongings:
- A pair of slippers with hard soles-no ties, please. They come untied.
- 2 pairs of mittens by the end of October • 2 hats by the end of October
- A complete change of clothes, including socks and underwear
- All clothing should be placed in an extra-large ziplock bag labeled with the student's name.
- Grades K-3 must have an easy reader available in the classroom at all times
- Grades 4 and up must have a chapter book available to read at school at all times.
- K-4 Child-Sized Scissors
- 1"-3 ring clear cover binder with tabbed binder dividers (6 tabs)

Grades SEVEN AND UP will also need:

- A geometric compass
- A protractor
- Regular Scissors
- 5, 100-sheet perforated notebooks that can be put into a binder
- A novel available to read at school at all times.

What is the discipline policy at Victory Academy?

We function on four basic Scriptural Principles



Show proper respect for everyone...

1 Peter 2:17

This simple principle covers most challenges that arise in a multitude of situations. Learning what respect looks like is far superior to enumerating dozens of individual rules and regulations. Focusing on this simple principle allows our students to widen the lens and look at a situation beyond, "He started it" or "It's not my fault!" Teaching children to ask themselves if a decision they have made is respectful, instills a character trait that serves them throughout their life.

For it is God who is working in you, enabling you both to desire and to work out his good purposes. Do everything without arguing or complaining


Philippians 2:13-14

This simple principle reminds us all who it is within us and the victory that gives us, as we seek to desire and become a part of His good purposes. We strive to help kids know what a privilege that is. We get to be a part of the good purposes of the CREATOR of the universe! Wow!

Truth is the foundation of every good purpose we referenced in the Philippians verse



Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry

Ephesians 4:26

We ask our students to leave their anger at the foot of the cross and make amends regarding any issues that come up during the day before they go home, rather than carry it around all throughout the days ahead and miss the blessings before them.

Students will be reminded as appropriate for their age of these rules. If a student is not prepared to follow these rules on any given day, that student will be asked to phone their parent/guardian, and that parent/guardian may be asked to come and pick the student up prior to the end of our instructional day..

Should my child bring a lunch and snack?

Yes, we ask that you pack a lunch with a healthy beverage and an additional healthy snack. We ask that any candy sent be limited to **1 fun size serving**, and that students **do not bring sugared-soda or commercially-sold energy drinks**. It is advisable to put a chill pack in your child's clearly marked lunch bag. All dishes that come to school. must be taken home the same day.

What if our family decides to take a vacation?

For maximum benefit of the consistent programming we offer, we encourage consistent attendance, but we also recognize the value of family travel. Going on a vacation that spills over into program days should be pre-arranged by working closely with your student's instructors to make arrangements for either remote programming via Zoom appointments or remote learning packets. Please be aware that it will require extra planning on the instructor's part to prepare packets or make arrangements for Zoom meetings, especially if you have multiple students. Should it be necessary, additional tutoring appointments can often be scheduled at an additional charge upon your return to bring your student up to speed.



Who should consider the possibilities Victory Alliance offers?



While the Victory Alliance program would benefit *any* dedicated homeschooling family seeking freedom and excellence in education, there are some families for whom it would be an extra good fit. Perhaps you or someone you know is one of those families.

- Single-parent families where the parent-teacher does double-time and has more tasks and ideas than day.

We do our very best to offer our programming at the lowest possible cost while still offering a fair wage to those who choose to step up and serve. Our credentialed instructors work eagerly and endlessly in and *out* of the classroom to deliver excellence while they are with your students. Curricula is constantly being reviewed, planned, sought out and adjusted. Evaluation of student progress is ongoing. These daily tasks are being carried out long before and after students arrive or leave our classrooms. While we never want our program to be an unattainable burden for our families, we likewise do not have an expectation that our staff will need to use their wages for daily classroom operations. Victory Alliance is an exciting Homeschool-hybrid program serving families and their students in and around Traverse City, MI. Our desire is to see students grow academically, socially, physically and spiritually, as we encourage them to discover the excellence of their identity in their good and kind Father above. We desire to bridge the gap between full time institutional drop-off education and schooling provided solely at home without additional peers or teachers. We are excited to be offering support and instruction in the core subjects as a part-time program. Families have plenty of time on off days for parents to do electives, pursue further study of core subjects, take field trips, do sports, music, and explore enrichment activities with their children. If you desire additional instruction for your student on off days, you can even check with your student's teacher about individualized tutoring that may be offered.

By enrolling your student at Victory Alliance, you are agreeing to the policies and procedures listed below.

Registration and Membership Fees

Victory Alliance does charge an application or registration fee, due to the fact that the program operates at nearly full capacity, often with a waitlist. There is a \$100 non-refundable deposit required for each family to reserve your spot. These deposits are non-refundable in the event you change your mind. Please note "deposit for (Insert children's names.)" in the memo.

For those who are registered with brightwheel.com invoices for membership fees will go out near the first of each month, and members are asked to strive to have their fees paid by the 10th. We do not charge late fees, but we ask that you use your own wisdom before the Lord to stay current month-to-month. You are invited to adopt a 9 or 12 month payment plan. We do not charge extra for a 12 month payment plan. Your first month is due by September 30th. Membership fees are best paid via brightwheel.com by setting up an account during the first week of classes and authorizing direct debit to your bank account or by paying with a credit card. There is a 3% fee for credit card usage, so direct-debit from your bank is highly recommended, as that fee is less than \$2.00. If you wish to pay on the premises by check or cash, please place payment in envelopes clearly labeled with your family's name, child's name, and month on the front of the envelope and make sure it is handed directly to a teacher.

Hours of Operation and Lunches

Our hours of operation are Tuesdays and Thursdays or Mondays and Wednesdays from 10:00 AM-4:00 PM.

Drop off at 9:50 AM and pick up no later than 4:10 PM on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Parents are responsible for drop-off, pick-up. The time outside of program hours is set-up, clean-up and planning time for the faculty. It is imperative your children are picked up in a timely manner so these tasks can be completed without distraction.

There will be a 45-60 minute lunch period for each class. Parents are responsible for providing a daily sack lunch, snack and a water bottle for each child. Water bottles should have a lid and be spill-proof. We do not allow soda coffee or energy drinks to be brought from home. Please give your student every advantage by limiting candy to fun-sized servings. Please do not send family-sized bags of chips or sugared drinks with your children. We do love to celebrate our students' birthdays, and because there are so many, there is no shortage of goodies. Please let us know if you would like to send a special treat on that day so that we may advise you of any allergies.

Volunteer Requirements

Victory Alliance *welcomes* parent volunteers, but volunteering is *optional*. Our greatest need and biggest blessing is to have parents available to supervise the students during lunch (12:00-1:00) to give the teachers some time to plan for the afternoon, eat their own lunch, or work with any student who needs some extra instruction. If you would like to volunteer for lunch time supervision, please sign up on day 1 or any day when you are picking up or dropping off your child. Additionally, you may express your interest in helping out on our Facebook page and we will assist you

Fundraising

Fundraising is often an important part of any educational program, and Victory Alliance is no exception. It is our desire to offer our students as many advantages as possible, and offer fair compensation to retain our excellent faculty and to keep membership rates as low as possible. Throughout the year, we may host fundraisers as needed to accomplish this. If you have ideas in this area, please let us know. We would prefer NOT to have our students selling merchandise, but rather to implement other creative ideas. Examples of things that can be done are: can collections, dessert auctions, talent shows, encore presentations of community performances, special speakers being invited in, and community service opportunities that also raise money.

Parents may also be asked occasionally to help provide supplies for academic activities, but it is the goal of Victory Alliance to provide most of these needed extras.

Dress Code

Victory Alliance does not have a specific dress code, nor do we require uniforms. We simply ask students to wear clean clothes and their best attitude.

Discipline Policy

Conduct that is respectful of peers, teachers and the learning community is expected of all students. Students are expected to adhere to their best reflection of their true identity of excellence. Our discipline policy includes the following three opportunities for the student to correct their actions and resume reflecting their best identity.

Step 1: A simple correction by the teacher to remind them of their excellent identity in Christ.

Step 2: A phone call to the parent by the student to indicate that they are struggling.

Step 3: An agreed upon plan between the parent and teachers to assist the student in better reflecting their best identity will be implemented.

Some of the issues that will be **immediately** addressed with a parent are:

- 1) Use of offensive or inappropriate language confirmed by teachers
- 2) Stealing
- 3) Disruptive outbursts
- 4) Inappropriate or excessive use of electronics

Issues that will likely result in immediate, permanent dismissal from the school include, but are not limited to:

- 1) Bullying (seeking to harm, emotionally or physically, intimidate or coerce)
- 2) Sexual Immorality (acts, speech or images)
- 3) Intentional destruction of property

If at any point the student is dismissed for disciplinary action, or parents choose to pull their child out, there will be no refunds of the current or previous months' membership fees will be refunded

We ask our students to resolve their frustrations and make amends regarding any issues that come up during the day prior to going home. Doing this before they go home prevents them from carrying it around all throughout their home time and being blinded to the blessings therein.

Electronics

All student cellphones and tablets will be placed in the student's mailbox upon arrival. Students will not have *unlimited* access to phones or tablets at Victory Alliance. Use of personal devices will be mainly limited to instructional or research purposes. We ask that any devices sent to Victory Alliance with students have parental controls installed to block access to inappropriate content on the web. Best case scenario is to block access to all social media apps during Victory Alliance instructional hours to give your students the most opportunity to benefit from the learning and mentoring environment. Please consult your owner's manual or call your provider to learn how to do this. If we can be of any assistance, we are happy to help. Victory Alliance supplies electronics that are equipped with any programs and apps needed to complete the work required. If a student is done with independent work and there is additional time left, downloads to VA devices may be permitted if they have a learning focus. For example, if there is additional time left at the end of math and the student has a math app such as Dreambox or Prodigy, they will be allowed to use the tablet for supplemental education during that

time. Students are asked to leave any personal laptops or tablets home that are equipped with social media sites or texting capabilities. Victory Alliance provides students with iPads/chromebooks to be left at school to use for lessons. No student is required to have a personal phone or tablet. Parents are strongly advised to put parent-control apps on their children's phones that are sent to school to be used at lunchtime. It is not possible for staff to supervise or be aware of texts, or web-surfing done by students at this time. Students will not be allowed to have their phones at the study tables during teaching times for recreationl usse.. Students who cannot follow this direction will be asked to leave their phones home.

Anyone wishing to contact their student during the day may call the student's phone, which will be on silent, and leave a voicemail or a text message. Phones will be checked by students at lunchtime. (12:00-1:00) If it is an emergency, please contact the teacher by phone or text, and they will return or deliver your message at the earliest point of convenience. Please so not ask your student to be watching for your texts throughout the day.

Miscellaneous Matters

We ask that children do not bring bikes, scooters, or hoverboards, or any other wheeled devices to Victory Alliance. The potential for injury presents a great deal of risk for the student and their peers, as children often share their "vehicles" with students who have less proficiency in navigating them.

While such is a given, let it be stated that no student is permitted to carry firearms or possess weapons on the property. Drugs or alcohol of any sort are not allowed on the grounds.

Once students arrive on our campus, they will not be allowed to leave the premises unless a parent or other designated adult picks them up. As a precaution and safety measure, doors will be locked from the outside for security purposes. Should you need to gain access during instructional hours please call the number posted on the door.

If a student drives to Victory Alliance, they must not arrive any earlier than 9:50 nor remain on the premises any later than 4:15. We ask that students park in the designated spaces and do not return to their vehicles at any time during the day, including recess or lunch times.
